## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DR. ROBERT E. OSLAR

of 219 Professional Bldg., El Cerrito, State of California, 94530, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Elk Creek and Drew Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River irrigation of 22.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 35115 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 21, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second, being 0.06 c.f.s. from Elk Creek and 0.22 c.f.s. from Drew Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Elk Cr.-SWz SE%, Section 11; Drew Cr.-NE% NE%, Section 15, T. 31 S., R. 2 W., W. M., Elk Cr.-780 feet North and 3020 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 11; Drew Cr.-1250 feet South and 850 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
