and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1879

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, measured at point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the NE's SE's, Section 12, T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M., 6120 feet South and 2270 feet East from the Center & Corner, Section 1.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.4 acres NE% SE% Section 12 T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M.

6.8 acres NW4 SW4 3.5 acres SW4 SW4 Section 7 T. 9 S., R. 28 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved July 11, 1957 and August 15, 1969, and together with certificate 36598 supersedes certificate of water right 25147.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
