CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PHILIP MURPHY

of Monument, State of Oregon, 97864, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Cottonwood Creek

a tributary of North Fork John Day River for the purpose of irrigation of 18.4 acres

under Permit No. 3638 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 9, 1917

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M., 6120 feet South and 2270 feet East from the Center $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
6.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M.

0.2 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 7
T. 9 S., R. 28 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order entered August 15, 1969, and together with certificate 36481 supersedes certificate 4783.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
