CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

a right to the use of the waters of
Neil Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 54.77 acres and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1854

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.68 cubic foot per
second

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Wells DLC 53, Section 12
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Tolman DLC 54, Section 13, T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W. M.,
1540 feet South and 200 feet East from the NW Corner, Wells DLC 53, 120 feet South
and 120 feet West from the NE Corner, Tolman DLC 54.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:
