CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **JOHN V. AND MOLLY CHASE BORTHAM**

of **Cloverdale Rd., Eugene**, State of **Oregon, 97426**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of **Bear Creek when available and any deficiency in Bear Creek to be made up by diversion from Coast Fork of Willamette River** a tributary of **Willamette River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 126.5 acres**

under Permit No. **23565** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **July 27, 1955** that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.97 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 2 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Callison DLC No. 50, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Littrel DLC No. 71, Section 6, T. 19 S., R. 2 W., W. H.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appur tant, is as follows:
