CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **A. D. DORITY, JR.**

of **P.O. Box 225, Lake Oswego**, State of Oregon, 97034, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of **Willamette River**

a tributary of **Columbia River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 110.0 acres**

under Permit No. **36113** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 1, 1971**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1.4 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **#1-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **Lucier DLC 65, Section 29; #2-Lot 6 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 30; #3-Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 31; all within T. 3 S., R. 2 W., W. M., #1-2770 feet North and 230 feet East; #2-390 feet North and 980 feet West; both from the NW Corner of Lot 12, Section 29; #3-1970 feet North and 1660 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner of Section 31.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**19.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
7.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
39.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
36.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$**

**All projected within Lucier DLC 65
Section 29**

**0.2 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
7.1 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$**

**Both projected within Lucier DLC 65
Section 32**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
