CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. A. BRADLEY

of Milton-Freewater, State of Oregon, 97862, has
a right to the use of the waters of a spring branch

a tributary of Walla Walla River for the purpose of
irrigating 70.91 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 208; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from May 3, 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.9 cubic foot per
second

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by prior
certificate 1014, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order entered on May 17,
1976.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
