of P. O. Box 160, Pilot Rock , State of Oregon, 97868 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek

a tributary of West Birch Creek irrigation of 29.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 34906 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 13, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.48 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the #1-SW, NE, Section 10, T. 2 S., R. 31 E., W. M., 2670 feet North and 1380 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 10; #2-NW, NW, Section 11, T. 2 S., R. 31 E., W. M., 390 feet South and 310 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
