CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RAYMOND J. BECKER

of Rt. 1, Box 568, Monroe , State of Oregon, 97456 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Fern Ridge Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 136.8 acres

under Permit No. 35618 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 25, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 301.0 acre feet of stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Starr DLC 49, Section 21, T. 14 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Long Tom River - 1700 feet North and 720 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 21; Reservoir - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, T. 17 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre, a diversion of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 14-06-100-6883 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
