of Rt. 1 Box 171, Clatskanie , State of Oregon, 97016 proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Ternahan Creek

Columbia River a tributary of Columbia River domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to for the purpose of exceed one-half acre in area and stock

under Permit No. 38508 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 3, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for stock and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX SEX. Section 24, T. 8 N., R. 4 W., W. M., 990 feet South and 700 feet West from the Ex Corner of Section 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Stock and Domestic Use NEW SEW Section 24 T. 8 N. 5 R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place to the existing minimum flow policies of use herein described Water Policy Review Board.
