## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

DESCRUTES VALLEY FARMS, INC.

of p. O. Box 166, Culver , State of Oregon 97734 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Deep Canyon Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation of 239.0 acres and supplemental irrigation of 120.0 acres

under Permit No.  $_{G-4974}$  and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

March 13, 1972
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.49 cubic feet per second, being 0.73 c.f.s. from Well #1 and 3.76 c.f.s. from Well #2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the #1 - SW<sub>2</sub> SE<sup>1</sup><sub>2</sub>, Section 18, #2 - NW<sub>2</sub> SW<sub>4</sub>, Section 19, T. 14 S., R. 12 E., W. M., Well #1 - 1050 feet North and 6980 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 17; Well #2 - 2380 feet North and 4420 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
