that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30,

The point of diversion is located in the NE's NE's, Section 12, T. 13 S., R. 27 E., W. M., 860 feet South and 1000 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 12

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
