## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Mills Creek and Gammill Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-45782,  
Permit No. R-5355  
a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of  
temperature control of 10.7 acres

under Permit No. 33846 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
February 17, 1969  
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
2.0 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 17, T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M.,  
450 feet North and 880 feet West from the S $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second  
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right  
is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
10.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 17  
T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies  
established by the Water Policy Review Board.
