CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DOROTHY CHARLEY

of Rt. 1, Box 290, Eagle Point, State of Oregon, 97524, has
a right to the use of the waters of Little Butte Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 2.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 14, at page 498; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1899

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per
second; measured at the point of diversion, from April 1st to October 1st of
each year.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, T. 36 S., R. 1 W., W. M.,
230 feet South and 920 feet East from the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 9

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

2.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 9
T. 36 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
September 15, 1966, and together with certificate 39591 and transfer 2672
supersedes certificate of water right 17228.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
