a tributary of Rogue River domestic use and irrigation of 140.0 acres for the purpose of

under Permit No. 2667 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 10. 1915

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.85 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the East Side Ditch - SEK NW4, Section 14, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.; 2250 feet South and 1900 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 14; SEK SEK, Section 3, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 500 feet North and 400 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion as well as to describe that portion of the right NOT modified by the provisions of the orders entered November 18, 1952 and November 20, 1964 approving transfers W-58 and Y-7. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
