and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from December 7,1880 for 19.5 acres
and 1898 for 210 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

10 cores in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-one: 5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 19 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 39 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Scuthwest quarter; 39 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-two: 37.5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-seven, Township Eight South, Range Forty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
