CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Rt. 1, Box 473, Dallas , State of Oregon, 97338 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Mill Creek

a tributary of Yamhill River irrigation of 8.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 24333 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 2, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE's SE's, as projected within Gilstrap DLC 53, Section 28, T. 6 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 400 feet South and 120 feet East from the NW Corner, Gilstrap DLC 53.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion and place of use as well as to describe that portion of the water right NOT modified by the order entered April 26, 1972, and supersedes certificate 24792.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
