that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three-eightieths of one cubic foot per second per acre of land irrigated, and not to exceed one and one-half acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days during the irrigation season.

The point of diversion is located in the NW NEZ, Section 26, T. 1 S., R. 48 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.25 acre NE% NW% Section 26 T. 1 S., R. 48 E., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 40407, Volume 32, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on October 14, 1976, approving transfer application No. 3476.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
