## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** **GEORGE G. FAX**

of Rt. 3, Box 32, The Dalles, State of Oregon, 97058, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Fifteen Mile Creek,

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of  
the irrigation of 1.2 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1872

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3 acre feet per acre  
in any irrigation season

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Peter Rudio DLC 38,  
Section 3, T. 1 S., R. 14 E., W. M., 370 feet South and 2180 feet West from the  
E $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner, Section 3.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

0.3 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
0.9 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Both as projected within Peter Rudio DLC 38  
Section 3  
T. 1 S., R. 14 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved December 17,  
1973, and together with certificate 40409 supersedes certificate 5630.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
