## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MILTON L. COOLEY

of 1650 Nebergall Loop Road, Albany , State of Oregon 97321 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 51.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-5029 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 19, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (SWL NEL), Section 32, T. 10 S., R. 3 W., W.M., 1530 feet South and 2620 feet West from NE Corner, Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.1 acres Lot 7 (NW4 NE4)
24.4 acres Lot 7 (SW4 NE4)
0.9 acre Lot 7 (SE4 NE4)
5.2 acres Lot 9 (NE4 NW4)
16.5 acres Lot 8 (SE4 NW4)
0.5 acre NE4 SW4
2.0 acres NW4 SE4
Section 32
T. 10 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

This certificate is issued to correct and supersede the prior certificate recorded on page 42585, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to correctly list the number of acres to be irrigated and to describe the place of use.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
