CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MAX & BERTHA L. OBLACK

of Mist , State of Oregon, 97016 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring area and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-44632, Permit No. R-5088 and Nehalem River with any deficiency in the available supply from spring * a tributary of Nehalem River for the purpose of fish culture

under Permit No. 32938 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 25, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 6 N., R. 4 W., W. M.; Spring Area - 400 feet South and 520 feet East; River - 700 feet South and 460 feet East both from the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* area and reservoir to be made up by appropriation from Nehalem River provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
