CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK H. & VIOLA M. GOULD

of Rt. 1, Box 599, Bandon, State of Oregon, 97411, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Crooked Creek

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of temperature control & harvesting cranberries

under Permit No. 35867 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 14, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second, being 0.42 c.f.s. for temperature control, and 0.37 c.f.s. for harvesting cranberries

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 29 S., R. 14 W., W. M., 480 feet North and 1250 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 7

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
3.4 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 18
T. 29 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
