CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **CLIFFORD J. WYKHOOP**

of **P. O. Box 973, Brookings**, State of **Oregon, 97415**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a **spring & Winchuck River**

a tributary of **Pacific Ocean** for the purpose of **domestic use of one family**

under Permit No. **32144** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **January 23, 1967**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.005 cubic foot per second; with any deficiency in the available supply from the spring to be made up by appropriation from Winchuck River provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.005 c.f.s.**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the **Spring - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; River - SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, both in Section 9, T. 41 S., R. 12 W., W. M., Spring - 1390 feet North and 700 feet West; River - 1310 feet North and 670 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 9.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
