## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** DALE B. CHRISTENSEN

of Rt. 2, Box 1418-A, Roseburg, State of Oregon, 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.4 acres

under Permit No. 28837 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 13, 1963 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within McKinney DLC 45, Section 23, T. 26 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 2980 feet South and 2510 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner, Section 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the North Umpqua River is more than 525 cubic feet per second at its mouth;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.6 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
As projected within McKinney DLC 45  
Section 14

0.8 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
As projected within McKinney DLC 45  
Section 23  
T. 26 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved February 15, 1974, and together with certificate 43554 supersedes certificate 35309.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
