that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL SEL, Section 1, T. 30 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 160 feet North and 280 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 1

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre fact per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
