CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **DITCH CREEK RANCH**

of Rt. 1, Box 178, Rogue River , State of Oregon, 97537 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Ditch Creek Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-46479, Permit No. R-5541

a tributary of Pleasant Creek for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 72.01 acres

under Permit No. 34738 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed, dates from October 10, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 7.5 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 2040 feet South and 230 feet East; Reservoir-2290 feet South and 820 feet East both from the NW Corner, Section 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre, a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
