CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DITCH CREEK RANCH

of Rt. 1, Box 178, Rogue River, State of Oregon, 97537, has a right to the use of the waters of Ditch Creek

a tributary of Pleasant Creek for the purpose of the irrigation of 84.59 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1877

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.28 cubic feet per second

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 29, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 125 feet North and 140 feet West from the NE 1/4 Corner, Section 32; SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 33, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 2040 feet South and 230 feet East from the NW Corner Section 33

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion and place of use approved by an order entered March 29, 1971 as well as to describe that portion of the water right confirmed by prior certificate 16138 NOT modified by the provisions of the same order.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
