for the purpose of

under Permit No. 30684 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 29, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 6.01 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of eversion is located in the NE% SE%, Section 11, T. 38 S., R. 10 E., W.M., 20 feet South and 2650 feet West from Ek Corner, Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre %rrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 40.0 acres NE's SW's 40.0 acres NW% SW% 40.0 acres SW's SW's 40.0 acres SE% SW% 33.0 acres NW SE 40.0 acres SW% SE% 7.4 acres SEk SEk Section 36 T. 37 S., R. 10 E., W.H.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
