CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WALLACE E. AYRES

of 3357 Agusta International, Salem, State of Oregon, 97302, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 64.2 acres

under Permit No. G-4582 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 7, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.81 cubic foot per second, being 0.43 c.f.s. from Well No. 5 and 0.38 c.f.s. from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the No. 2-Lot 11 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 21; No. 3-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 15 S., R. 4 W., W. M., No. 2-530 feet South and 690 feet West; No. 3-2210 feet South and 1670 feet West; both from the NE Corner, Lot 11 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
