CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

U. S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
FOREST SERVICE

of Lowell Ranger District, Lowell, State of Oregon, 97452, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Fall Creek for the purpose of public campground

under Permit No. 29977 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 9, 1964 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.022 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, T. 18 S., R. 2 E., W. M., 750 feet South and 2858 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
