## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

GEORGE G. WHITE

of Route 1, Box 61, Mt. Angel , State of Oregon 97362 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Butte Creek

a tributary of Pudding River irrigation of 60.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 23008 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 11, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SW4, Section 5, T. 6 S., R. 1 E., W.M., 1800 feet North and 530 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.75 acres NE4 SE4 39.75 acres NW4 SE4 13.00 acres SW4 SE4 2.50 acres SE4 SE4 Section 6 T. 6 S., R. 1 E., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use as well as to describe that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded on page 41618, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of the order entered May 31, 1974. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
