CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROY HATHAWAY

of Rt. 3 Box 393-A, Corvallis , State of Oregon 97330 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a channel of the Willamette River

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 52.8 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 35771 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 3, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.66 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 10 (NW NEK), Section 31, T. 12 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 3290 feet South and 40 feet East from the Center of Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

confirm to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre Lot 5 (SE½ SW½) 17.5 acres Lot 7 (SW½ SE½) Section 30

17.1 acres Lot 10 (NW/c NE/c)
