CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

FRANK GEHRMAN

of Rt. 1, Box 298, Molalla , State of Oragon, 97938 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Butte Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 5.9 acres and supplemental irrigation of 7.5 acres

under Permit No. C-4733 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 31, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL SWL, as projected within Burbage DLC 37, Section 2, T. 6 S., R. 1 E., W. M.; 1840 feet North and 1030 feet West from the SE Corner, Burbage DLC 37.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
