under Permit No. 24893 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dutes from May 3, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.05 c.f.s. from Big Queen Hot Spring and 0.03 c.f.s. from Drip Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4, NE4 SW4, Section 30, T. 6 S., R. 7 E., W. M., Big Queen Hot Spring-North 8 degrees 30 minutes East 178 feet; Drip Creek-South 66 degrees 30 minutes West 600 feet, both from the Center, Section 30

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right

is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order entered December 12, 1968 as well as to describe that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate 30141 NOT modified by the provisions of the same order. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes afcresaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
