## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CLIFFORD L. WOLFSWINKEL

of 4219 East Indian School Rd., Phoenix , State of Arizona 85018 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Hall Creek and Buffalo Lake Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-38082, Permit No. R-3196

a tributary of Silvies River

for the purpose of

supplemental irrigation of 212.9 acres

under Permit No. 28501 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 25, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.66 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE%, SE% SE%, Section 26, T. 18 S., R. 31 E., W. M., Creek-2850 feet North and 2600 feet West; Reservoir-280 feet North and 810 feet West, both from the SE Corner, Section 26

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightietlpf one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Mermit No. R-3196;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

34.6 acres NE's NW's
32.0 acres NW's NW's
32.0 acres SW's NW's
36.8 acres SE's NW's
39.0 acres NE's SW's
38.5 acres NW's SW's
Section 36
T. 18 S., R. 31 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
