of 3685 Davis Dr., Hood River , State of Oregon, 97031 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Davis Spring and Davis Creek

a tributary of Odell Creek irrigation of 14.0 acres and orchard spraying

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 34471 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 19. 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second, being 0.18 c.f.s. for irrigation from Davis Creek and 0.01 c.f.s. for spraying from Davis Spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWM NWM, Section 35; SWM, Section 26, T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M., spring-170 feet South and 410 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 35; creek-540 feet North and 470 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 26

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Orchard Spraying & 14.0 acres SW4 SW4 Section 26
T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
