CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CITY OF ASHLAND

of Ashland, State of Oregon, 97520, has
a right to the use of the waters of Ashland Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of
municipal use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1885

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot
per second

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W.
M., 100 feet North and 10 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 20

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

City of Ashland

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and point of diversion
approved by an order entered February 17, 1969 and supersedes certificate 16019.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
