CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

DONALD F. AND MABLE C. MILBURN

of 1791 Missouri Flat, Grants Pass , State of Oregon, 97526 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rocky Gulch and spring

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and the irrigation of 5.4 acres

under Permit No. 31448 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 24, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from spring for domestic and 0.07 c.f.s. from Rocky Gulch for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4, Section 24, T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Spring-1220 feet North and 1000 feet West; Rocky Gulch-1280 feet North and 500 feet West, both from the SE Corner, SW4 NE4, Section 24

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 5.4 acres SW4 NF4 Section 24 T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
