## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** BARKER TIMBER COMPANY

of P. O. Box 806, Eugene, State of Oregon, 97401, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Farnam Creek & Farnam Creek Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-46448, Permit No. R-5537 a tributary of Siuslaw River for the purpose of Recreation

under Permit No. 34730 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 26, 1969 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, T. 20 S., R. 5 W., W. P., 350 feet South and 400 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner, Section 11

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

This right is subject to the terms and conditions of an agreement between the Oregon State Game Commission and the applicant recorded in the miscellaneous records of the Water Resources Department and by reference made a part hereof.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
