CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

LEWIS E. HOOSE

of 3988 Timber Trail N.E., Silverton , State of Oregon, 97381 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream & Hoose Reservoir No. 1 constructed under Application No. R-47595, Permit No. R-5612

a tributary of Powers Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 15.2 acres and supplemental irrigation of 19.0 acres

under Permit No. 34996 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 30, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.43 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL SEL, Section 4, T. 7 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 500 feet North and 1250 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same binds, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5612

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
