CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

THE REED INSTITUTE

of 3203 S.E. Woodstock Blvd., Portland , State of Oregon, 97202 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Crystal Springs Creek and Reed Lake Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-41866, Permit No. R-4658 a tributary of Johnson Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 31.5 acres

under Permit No. 30846 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 13, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.39 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE% SW4, as projected within Long DLC 56, Section 13, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 200 feet North and 1480 feet West from the NE Corner, Llewellyn DLC 49

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 24 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4658

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.2 acres NEW SW4 5.1 acres SE% SW% 8.9 acres NWk SEk 2.3 acres SW4 SE4 All as projected within Llewellyn DLC 49 Section 13 T. 1 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. an a subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Wate. licy Review Board. VITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed
