CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EARL L. HOWARD

of Box 281, Mosier, State of Oregon, 97040, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of spring #2, unnamed creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-51810, Permit No. R-6111

a tributary of Mosier Creek for the purpose of domestic use for two families, irrigation of 16.1 acres and supplemental irrigation of 0.3 acre under Permit No. 37763

and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 14, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from spring #2 for domestic, and 0.23 c.f.s. from spring #2, unnamed creek and reservoir for irrigation and supplemental irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, T. 2 N., R. 11 E., W. M., spring #2-240 feet North and 720 feet East; unnamed creek-10 feet South and 730 feet East; reservoir-100 feet North and 880 feet East, all from the Center, Section 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-6111

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Spring #2, unnamed creek, & reservoir

15.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

0.3 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

Spring #2

Domestic & 0.3 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
