a tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 47.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 35797 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 29, 1972
that the amount of super to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.59 cubic foot per second, being 0.49 c.f.s. from Applegate River and 0.10 c.f.s. from Slagle Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWA SWA, Section 6, T. 38 S., R. 4 W., W. M., SEA NEA, Section 1, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Applegate River-4000 feet South and 80 feet East; Slagle Creek-2050 feet South and 240 feet West, both from the NE Corner, Section 1, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

27.6 acres SW4 NE4 7.4 acres SE4 NE4 11.0 acres NE4 SE4 1.0 acres NW4 SE4 Section 35 T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
