## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

has a right to the use of

the waters of Lover Timbered Canyon or Coin Creek, tributary of Powder River and Powder River, tributar of Snake River for the purpose of the irrigation of 41 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 29% that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1901 for 14 acres and 1893 for 27 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said docree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

7 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 7 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 12 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 2.5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 12.5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-nine, Township Nine South, Range Forty-five East of Willsmette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of usc herein described.
