## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** PORTLAND STATE COLLEGE

of P. O. Box 751, Portland, State of Oregon, 97207, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of air conditioning

under Permit No. G-3965 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 23, 1968 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.80 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Chapman DLC 46, Section 4, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 1496 feet North and 1237 feet East from the NW Corner, Corothers DLC 43

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

This right is subject to the provision that use of water for air conditioning in excess of 5,000 gallons per day shall be subsequent in priority to future beneficial consumptive use unless a two well system is constructed and all water wasted from the system is recharged to the same ground water reservoir from which it was withdrawn.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
