CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That BIRD SPAULDING & W. B. VAUGHN

of Baker, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Elk Creek, Burlap and Juniper Gulches, tributary of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 436 acres of land and for storage of 500 acre ft., and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from April 25, 1906 for 65 acres; 1875 for 33 acres; April 25, 1906 for 70 acres; 1872 for 67.3 acres; 1907 for 50 acres; 1911 for 10 acres; 1873 for 35.7 acres; 1905 for 60 acres and May 25, 1906 for 45 acres that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 20 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 30 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Seven; 33 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Five; 37 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 37 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 35 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 18 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 36 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 25 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 33 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 27 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Six: Township Ten South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
