CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LANE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

of 4000 East 30th Ave., Eugene, State of Oregon, 97405, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a reservoir constructed under Application No. R-46132, Permit No. R-5493

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of Ecological and hydraulic studies

under Permit No. 34592 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 3, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.52 acre foot stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Coryell DLC 49, Section 15, T. 18 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 200 feet North and 756 feet West from the SW Corner, Wm. Moore DLC 60, Section 15

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows.

As projected within Coryell DLC 49
Section 15
T. 18 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
