CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That**ERNEST HENRY MYERS
(CEDAR LANE PARK)**

of 20432 14th W., Lynnwood, , State of Washington, 98036 has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork Scappoose Creek

a tributary of Scappoose Creek for the purpose of domestic use for 28 families (Trailer Park)

under Permit No. 34403 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 23, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE~~1~~ SE~~1~~, as projected within Timothy Lamberson DLC 42, Section 2, T. 3 N., R. 2 W., W. M., 672 feet South and 53 feet West from the NW Corner, Timothy Lamberson DLC 42

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
