for the purpose of

under Permit No. 38606 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

May 14, 1975 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SW4, Section 29, T. 16 S., R. 12 E., W. M., 2425 feet North and 812 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 29

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _______of one cubic foot per second per acre, provided further that the right to use of water is limited from April 1 to November 1 of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW SW2 Section 29 T. 16 S., R. 12 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as Lot 15, Deschutes River Homesites, Rimrock Addition Deschutes County.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
