CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SMOKEY M. OVERTON

of Star Route, Mt. Vernon, State of Oregon, 97865, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Fields Creek & John Day River.

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 11.9 acres and supplemental irrigation of 40.3 acres

under Permit No. 31781 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 19, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.1 cubic feet per second, being 0.3 c.f.s. from Fields Creek for irrigation & 0.8 c.f.s. from John Day River for supplemental irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 13 S., R. 28 E., W. M., Fields Creek; 1-1270 feet South and 1170 feet West; 2-500 feet South and 780 feet West; 3-410 feet North and 100 feet West; 4-660 feet North and 40 feet East; 5-1030 feet North and 600 feet East; John Day River-1560 feet North and 1060 feet East, All from the S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from John Day River and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from Fields Creek.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
